# Pop Tab Program

Little things mean a lot...

Saving pop tabs is easy, fun and good for the environment! They're compact with a high concentration of recyclable aluminum. Since 2000, recycling little aluminum tabs from the tops of cans has generated over \$360,000 for the Ronald McDonald House. Revenue from recycling these little bits of aluminum helps keep families near their children who are receiving medical treatment in the Milwaukee area.

Here's how you can help:

Here are four options for recycling the pop tabs:

- Plan to attend Tab Toss Day on Saturday, May 18, 2019 from 12:00-2:00 p.m. at Winter Services, 2100 S. 116th St. Milwaukee, WI 53227.
- Drop off your tabs at any Great Clips located in the greater Milwaukee area.
- Drop your tabs off at the Ronald McDonald House on Watertown Plank Road in Milwaukee, any day between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m.
- Take the pop tabs to your local recycling center and have the check made out to Ronald McDonald House Charities and mail it to 8948 Watertown Plank Road, Milwaukee, WI 53226.
